ENTRY RULES

We will accept entries postmarked on or after March 8, 2010 **until the limit is reached** or the Closing Date, Saturday, March 27. If the entry limit is reached before all entries have been accepted, priority entry will be given by postmark date, i.e. all entries postmarked on March 8 will be entered first, those postmarked on March 9 will be next, etc. Priority will be given to those who volunteer for the trial. No express entries will be accepted. **In the past, this trial has filled quickly, so postmark your entries on March 8 to have the best chance to get in!**

THERE WILL BE NO CHECK-IN! Verifying your registration number is your responsibility. **Handlers with dogs 18" or under entered in Proficient without permanent height cards must present their dogs for measurement before they run.** Dogs entered in Skilled DO NOT have to be measured. **I will contact you if your dog needs to be measured.** Permanent height card measurements will be available during the weekend.

CONFIRMATIONS

Confirmations will be **emailed** as soon as possible **after the trial closes**. BE SURE to include your **CURRENT legible** email address on the entry form. If you do not include an email address, your confirmation will be mailed by US Postal Service. **SET YOUR EMAIL TO RECEIVE MESSAGES FROM MY EMAIL ADDRESS (fiasheltiemom@gmail.com)! If by April 1 you do not receive a confirmation or a notice that your entry has not been accepted, immediately contact the trial secretary, Lynda J. King, (fiasheltiemom@gmail.com) or phone (541 757 8074).**

CHANGES We will accept written (email OK) changes to your entry until **6 pm, Monday, April 5**. There will be no **CHANGES** or day-to-day move-ups at this trial.

DIRECTIONS to JACKSON COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

From I-5 (heading north or south) take exit 33 at Central Point. Central Point is two miles north of Medford. Head east and turn left at the Peninger Lane signal light. For day parking, enter at the first gate, and for camping, continue on to Gate 5 (Livestock Gate) to enter the grounds, and follow signs to the **BEAUTIFUL COMPTON ARENA!!**.

This is a heated, indoor arena with a packed dirt surface. We wish to be welcomed back, so PLEASE . . .

- *Pick up after your dog!*
- *Keep your dog on leash when not competing!*
- *Do not smoke in buildings or arena!*
- *Keep your dogs and children under control!*

NADAC RULES AND REGULATIONS

NADAC DOG REGISTRATION NUMBERS

You must register your dog(s) with NADAC. Dogs can be registered on-line at the NADAC web site at www.nadac.com (click on "Dogs" on the Home Page and then on "Dog Reg. Form").

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

SKILLED AND PROFICIENT CATEGORIES

Dogs must be entered in either the Skilled or the Proficient category. A dog may not be entered in Skilled one day and Proficient on another day. Dogs may enter the Skilled or Proficient category in the Standard, Veteran, or Junior Handler Division.

If you enter the Skilled category, you must run your dog at one jump height lower than its standard jump height. (Four inches will remain the minimum jump height.) Dogs are allotted the standard course time for, and are scored and placed in, the jump height entered.

Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current NADAC Exhibitor's Handbook. A copy of the current Exhibitor's Handbook may be downloaded for free from the NADAC website. Or Exhibitors may request a hard copy of the current Exhibitor's Handbook by sending \$5.00 to: North American Dog Agility Council, P.O. Box 1206, Colbert, OK 74733-1206.

AWARDS

Purple rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying runs. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in each jump height in Novice classes. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for each jump height and class for all other levels. Chances is pass/no pass and thus no placement ribbons will be awarded.

TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), with Rogue Canine Agility (RCA) as the host club. Exhibitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. **ALL DOGS MUST HAVE A NADAC REGISTRATION NUMBER.**
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, **must** be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization(s). Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his/her owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- There shall be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- A 100% refund will be given for any requests for withdrawals received prior to the Closing Date. After the Closing Date until 24 hours before the trial, refunds will be given for bitches in heat, injured or ill dogs (with verification from a vet upon request) or family emergency, less a \$20.00 handling fee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks,

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. .
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Rogue Canine Agility, Inc. (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and the Jackson County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
